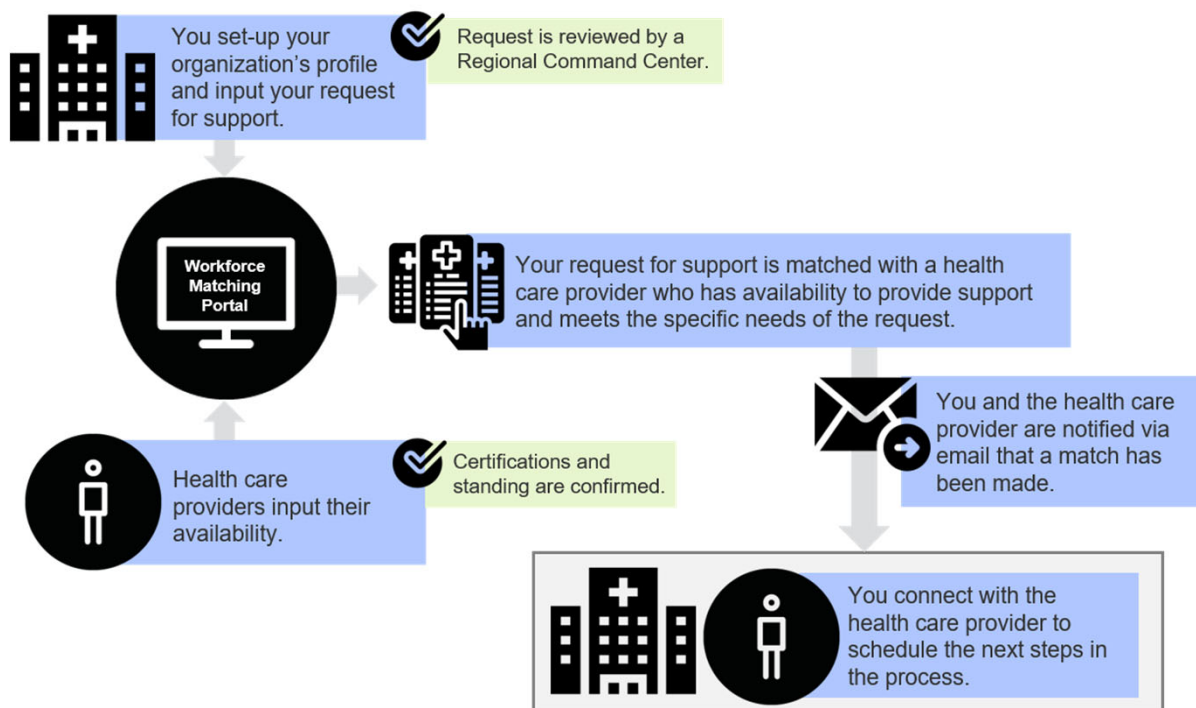
**Access the Ontario Health Workforce Matching Portal today to be matched with a health care provider who is available to provide support.**
