DO YOU NEED A MASK?

YES, YOU DO IF:

- You have respiratory symptoms such as fever, cough, congestion or runny nose
- You are visiting a patient on an inpatient unit who has been placed on special precautions due to an infection





NO, BECAUSE:

If you don't have any respiratory symptoms, it's not necessary for the general public to wear procedure or surgical masks to prevent infection.
