2009 Public Sector Salary Disclosure

On March 31, 2010, the fourteenth publication of the Public Sector Salary Disclosure (PSSD) or Ontario's "Sunshine List", will be made public.

Under the *Public Sector Salary Disclosure Act, 1996* (PSSDA), organizations receiving funding from the Province of Ontario, which includes hospitals, are required to disclose the names, positions, salaries and taxable benefits of employees earning over \$100,000 in a calendar year.

Amendments have been made to Regulation 85/96 of the Act, and a new administrative requirement has been introduced. To view these changes, download the Guide to Preparing Your 2009 Report, by visiting www.fin.gov.on.ca/en/publications/salarydisclosure/2010. In the section, "What's New This Year?", hospitals will find a brief outline of these changes. The various PSSD-related templates/forms are also available on the website.

All employers subject to the PSSDA are required to submit their disclosure records to their funding ministries by **Friday, March 5, 2010**.
