Thank you for supporting Ontario's hospital-to-hospital redeployment effort with volunteer staff to assist hospitals with high COVID activity. Your support has been vital in helping some of the hardest hit hospitals and preserving system capacity across Ontario.

As you may be aware from recent updates, the health system is starting to look forward and plan for the gradual resumption of non-emergent and non-urgent surgeries and procedures. With that in mind, we are officially closing our request for new volunteers.

Volunteer staff who have been redeployed and placed in hospitals will continue their placements and will return to their home organization as agreed with the receiving organization.
