RE: Hospital Incremental COVID-19 Expenses

I am pleased to provide an update on the release of new expense guidelines related to incremental COVID-19 expenses being incurred by hospitals in Ontario.

At this time, the Ministry of Health (ministry) has received incremental expense submissions for the months of March 2020 (2019-20 Fiscal Year), and April – November (2020-21 Fiscal Year). To help hospitals in managing cash flow, submitted operating expenses for March to September 2020 have been reimbursed. The ministry remains committed to regular reimbursement of capital and operating expenses as we progress through the year and we will be in communication regarding approaches for reimbursement and accrual as we approach year end.

As previously communicated, the ministry will keep the Extraordinary COVID-19 Expense Claim process open until March 31, 2021, as we recognize hospitals may be called upon to aid in other efforts as we manage the province's pandemic response, including areas such as Long-Term Care, Vaccine Administration and Critical Care capacity. With that in mind, attached is the most recent version of the 'COVID-19 Hospital Expense Guidance Document' (Version 5).

As with previous versions, Hospitals are directed to track all COVID-19 incremental expenses incurred, attest to and submit them to their respective Local Health Integration Network (LHIN)/Ontario Health (OH) Region for review prior to submission to the ministry. Version 5 includes updates to the guidelines for expense reporting and reimbursement process as well as a revised excel submission template.

As previously communicated, the ministry is committed to working closely with hospitals to uphold the notion of fair treatment of COVID-19 expenses. As such, we are working with Ontario Health in analyzing and validating reimbursed expenses, with potential recovery and reconciliation exercises to be completed thereafter. In turn, the ministry asks that hospitals continue to maintain detailed financial records for these expenses and submit to the ministry as requested.

Finally, the ministry is examining multiple reconciliation options related to hospital funding and is working with the Ontario Hospital Association on how we may offer flexibility given the extraordinary circumstances this year. These options however are not final, and any recommended option will need government approval.

Thank you for your continued commitment to delivering high quality care to patients during this unprecedented time.
