# Submission Guidelines

## Content Guidelines

In addition to the editorial content themes noted above, the OHA invites stories that demonstrate:

- **Hospital leadership in driving innovation and redesigning care** (examples include the development of new models of care, collaborative efforts to integrate care or design solutions to address system challenges, tools and resources developed to benefit providers or improve care).
- **Scientific, technological, and clinical advancements to improve care** (examples include hospital research discoveries and initiatives along with the application of technology, such as AI, in health care).
- **Passion for health care** (examples include stories about health care providers and leaders, including researchers and educators, making a difference in their community and improving care for patients and their families).

## Your submission should consider these questions:

- What can health system partners learn from this story?
- What are the key takeaways, lessons learned or best practices?
- How does this help shape our thinking and offer a different perspective?

## Submission Requirements

- Each story that is submitted should have the following indicated in a single Word document:
  - > **Title:** The title/headline should be engaging and brief
  - > **Byline/author**
  - > **Photo caption (if appropriate)**
  - > **Include appropriate links within the copy, including the citing of sources**
- The recommended article length is between 500-750 words and should be free of factual errors.
- Please send a **high-resolution image/photo** to accompany the article in .jpg format. Horizontal orientation works best.
- You may also submit additional images, graphics/diagrams, and video links to supplement your article.

## Editorial Process

Please note that submissions will be assessed by the editorial team. To be considered for publication, all articles must be educational and informative, rather than promotional. An organization may be mentioned, and its services described as a background to provide context to readers, but “advertorials” will not be accepted.

Articles may be copy-edited by the OHA prior to publication and may be returned to the author for re-writing and/or approval if major changes are required. The OHA maintains final editorial control and articles accepted for publication become the property of the OHA, along with reprinting rights and electronic rights.

Submitted articles will be reviewed, and if accepted, will be published on the website in the subsequent issue following the submission deadline and shared through the OHA’s social media networks, as well as a monthly e-newsletter.
